

# McKinney-Vento Reporting Form

The term "families in transition" means individuals who lack a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence includes— children and youths who are sharing the housing of other persons due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or similar reason; are living in motels, hotels, trailer parks, or camping grounds due to lack of alternative adequate accommodations; are living in emergency or transitional shelters; are abandoned in hospitals; or are waiting foster care placement, children and youth who are living in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus or train stations, or similar settings. The term "unaccompanied youth" includes youth in transitional living situations who are not in the physical custody of a parent or guardian.
