Audience participation:

Please direct your comments to the Board as a whole. Comments become part of the public record. Speakers are cautioned not to use names of individuals, especially students. Any documentation or items a speaker wishes to share with the board should be given to Mrs. Cadrette, the recording secretary of the board, who will distribute the materials to board members after the board meeting. While addressing the Board of Education, you have three minutes for your remarks. Public comment callers will be placed in a virtual "waiting room." The moderator will answer calls in the order they are received and add the caller's audio to the meeting for them to make a comment. While speaking, callers/public commenters should either leave the room where your device is streaming the meeting OR mute the device streaming the meeting. This is so the public comments do not echo from being heard via two devices at the same time. Once your comment is concluded and you have concluded the call, you may go back to the audio from the device streaming the meeting.
