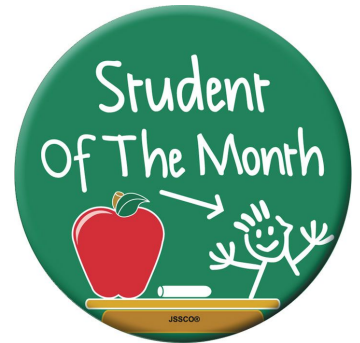

NO it is not a TRICK it is a real TREAT!

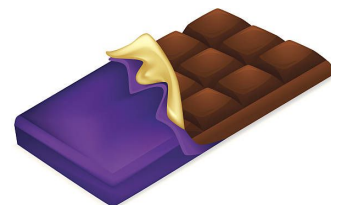
