2019-2020

1. Shorts are permitted as long as the shorts reach the middle of the thigh, defined as shoulders relaxed and arms straight down alongside the body where fingertips touch the thigh;
2. Skirts are permitted as long as the skirt reaches the middle of the thigh, defined as shoulders relaxed and arms straight down alongside the body where fingertips touch the thigh. Slits in the skirt may not rise more than two inches above fingertips;
3. Sleeveless shirts are permitted as long as two fingers' width of fabric covers both shoulders, and the chest area and undergarments are not exposed. This includes spaghetti straps;
4. Midriff area (front and back) must not be visible at any time, even while seated;
5. Undergarments must not be visible at any time;
6. Chest area must not be visible at any time;
7. Pants must be secured no lower than mid-hip and must not cover the front of the shoes while walking;
8. Open-toed shoes with a hard sole are permitted as long as the shoes do not pose a safety hazard. Flip-flops and slides are prohibited;
9. All footwear must be worn properly so that you walk normally throughout the building (i.e. walking so that you don't crease your shoes is prohibited);
10. Headwear is not permitted. This includes, but is not limited to, hats, visors, bandannas, and hoods. (Exceptions may be granted based on religious and medical reasons with proper verification);
11. Students are not permitted to wear hoods inside the building;
12. Sunglasses are not permitted except during outdoor activities;
13. Sleepwear and sleepwear-type clothing are not permitted. (Exceptions are granted for certain activities, such as overnight field trips);
14. Jewelry that poses a safety hazard to the student or other students is not permitted;
15. Sports uniforms that are worn during the school day must conform to the dress code;
16. Clothing that displays or symbolizes any language or material that is inappropriate for school or offensive to any group is not permitted. This includes, but is not limited to, material relating to drugs, alcohol, profanity, obscenity, racism, gang activity and violence;
17. The dress code is in effect on all field trips and at all on-campus school-sponsored events.

**Note: Administrators have the flexibility to exercise their judgment to determine if a student's attire is considered disruptive or distracting**
